ROBERT'S RULES OF ORDER, the authoritative playbook on how to run a meeting, stipulates that meetings should include a segment called the "Good of the Order." This is time that is reserved for participants to offer comments or observations about the organization and its work. It is also time set aside for disciplinary matters involving fellow members.

That's what the phrase "the good of the order" means to those who are skilled parliamentarians. But when I hear this phrase, I also think about the Knights of Columbus. I think about the good of our Order, founded in 1882 by Venerable Father Michael J. McGivney. Not even he could have imagined how his beloved Order would grow and the world of good it would do for its members, their families, the Church, and communities all over the world.

#### STRONG OPINIONS

I think about who makes up the Knights of Columbus and all that it does in service of others, and I ask myself, "How can I promote the good of the Order? Left to my own resources, I can't adequately answer that question, for the good of the Order cannot be reduced merely to my opinions. The same is true of every Knight of Columbus. The Order we joined is not a debating society, nor is it an arena where we play out a contest of wills. Rather, it is an organization rooted in charity, which expresses itself in genuine unity of mind and heart and in a brotherhood of service. In fact, our ability to do great good for our members, our Church and our world depends on our willingness to preserve and strengthen this solidarity.

Time and again, I have experienced the great dedication of many brother Knights. ## An Executive's Downsizing ... and Tragic Aftermath

Carlos was 48 years old. Recently downsized, he was working part-time until he could find more gainful employment. He didn't expect to work part-time for long. He had current skills and had saved enough to wait for the right opportunity. Interviews were already in the works.

The day hadn't been overly stressful, but waking up in the ambulance told a different story. The IV had been placed in his arm, the siren was on, and he was told that he had suffered a heart attack. With no time left to ask more questions, he was rushed quickly down the hallway for testing. Carlos survived that heart attack. He didn't survive the next one, nine months later.

Carlos died with no company life insurance. He lost that as part of the downsizing. His \$100,000 personal policy was little comfort when his wife looked at their growing children and realized the fear of providing for the kids on just her income. Could she remain independent and not burden the rest of her family? She wasn't sure. It would be hard.
