International Free Throw Championship Winner

Caleb Cook, a student at St. Agnes School, was crowned the *International Champion* in the 13-year old boys category of the Knights of Columbus Free Throw Championship for 2020-2021.



Caleb had to compete in and win several rounds of competition to become Champion. First, Caleb had to make the most out of 15 free throws in the St. Agnes School competition. After outshooting his classmates, Caleb competed against four other boys representing St. Francis of Assisi, Christ the King, and Queen of All Saints Schools at the District Competition.

After making the most out of 25 free throws, Caleb went on to compete at the Diocesan level where he beat 12 other boys. Then it was on to the California State competition where Caleb again bested his competitors – this time, 16 of them, to become California State Champion.

The Knights of Columbus are now present in 17 countries around the world, however not all competed in the Free Throw Championship. But among those that did, Caleb once again bested them all to become the *International Champion* in the 13-year old boys category of the Knights of Columbus Free Throw Championship for 2020-2021.
