the State Department announced that it would give \$32 million to the Rohingya Muslims fleeing the violence in Burma. While we applaud the assistance of any group in need of humanitarian assistance, the nearly 2 million members of the Knights of Columbus are deeply concerned that to this day, the largest displaced Christian population in Iraq has received no direct support from the United States government. The United States has an admirable history of helping genocide victims. Our government donated millions to the Christians of Armenia and the Middle East following the First World War. It prioritized Jewish refugees following the Second World War. It donated billions to those targeted for genocide in Darfur a decade ago. But for these Christian victims of ISIS, it has done almost nothing. Many Yazidis too have received no American help.

Never before has the United States treated a group targeted for genocide so poorly or ignored it more completely.

Not helping these people return home is contrary to American national security interests as foreign forces hostile to the United States roam there freely. Still, our government has taken no action to help them. During the campaign, and after the election, President Trump has stated clearly that the previous policy of leaving these genocide victims out of U.S. government aid programs behind had to change. In addition, the Consolidated Appropriations Act in May covering Fiscal Year 2017 mandated that these communities receive American government aid. The fiscal year ends this week, and yet neither the president's promises nor the statutory obligation have been fulfilled by either USAID or the State Department.
