

Brothers:

November is National Long-Term Care (LTC) Awareness Month. The following information is provided to help you better understand LTC and how to pay for it, if you should need it (which is very likely – read on).

- About 70% of people over the age of 65 will need some kind of LTC services during their lifetime.
- They will need those LTC services for an average of 3 years.
- 78% of adults who are getting LTC services at home rely solely on family and friends for their assistance.
- Over 90% of family caregivers had to alter their work schedule permanently due to caring for their loved one.
- In the San Francisco Bay Area, a private room in a skilled nursing facility averages almost \$14,000 per month. For a one-bedroom apartment in an assisted living facility, the average cost is over \$6,500 per month. The following charts compare average costs for the U.S., California, and the San Francisco Bay Area. The percent difference from the national average shown atop each column.

There will be a live band, featuring our own Brother John Wright on bass, and guest speaker Patrick Kimes, a 30-year police officer, who will be speaking on "Policing in California in 2021."

October Knight of the Month - PGK David Wood



← Past Grand Knight David Wood receives his Knight of the Month Award for October 2021. Brother David was instrumental in bringing back our monthly pancake breakfasts after a 20-month hiatus due to COVID restrictions. Even the fact that parishioners had to eat their breakfasts outdoors and many Knights had to be stationed outdoors to serve coffee and juice was not enough to throw off Brother David's planning and execution.







- Traditional medical insurance programs and government medical insurance programs don't usually provide enough help Medicare only pays for LTC services for a maximum of 100 days, with a co-pay after the 20th day, and only if certain criteria are met. Medicaid will pay for LTC, but only if your income is below a certain level (you are basically indigent), and you meet strict state requirements.
- Knights of Columbus LTC Insurance policies establish a pool of money (Lifetime Benefit), which is determined by a number of options that you

choose from (see below). That pool of money is then available for you to use to cover qualified long-term care expenses. When the pool of money is exhausted, your long-term care policy ends.

What options do I have?

- Coverage Type
 - * Comprehensive Covers expenses at home or in a skilled nursing facility.
 - * Facility-Only Covers expenses in skilled nursing or assisted living facility.
- Benefit Period
 - * 3-Year A lifetime benefit to cover 3 years of LTC expenses.
 - * 5-Year A lifetime benefit to cover 5 years of LTC expenses.
 - * 10-Year A lifetime benefit to cover 10 years of LTC expenses.
- Daily Benefit
 - * You establish the daily benefit amount that the policy provides, based on your budget and your projected need. Your daily benefit amount, combined with your benefit period, will determine your maximum lifetime benefit, all of which will affect your premium.
- Elimination Period
 - * The elimination period serves as your deductible or out-of-pocket amount. You can select a 30,- 90-, or 180-day lifetime elimination period, after which time your benefits will begin to be paid.
