George served as Grand Knight of the Concord Council 6038 1994-96 and again in 2009-2010.

George was also the Faithful Navigator of the Todos Santos Assembly 1996-97. George also served as a District Deputy 2001-2004 and during that time he helped formed the St. Frances and Queen of All Saint Councils. George was the Chapter President 2006-2007. In 2011 George helped form the St. Agnes Council and served as Treasurer until 2016.

There are so many more groups and organizations Brother George was involved with and influenced their communities as well. A bright light for the whole world that has moved on and will be dearly missed.
